## Chronology of Budokan

<b>Old building</b> 1936	Budokan initially opened in the Yokohama Park, administered by the Kanagawa Prefectural Government (K. P. G.) Education Bureau.	<b>New building</b> 1982	The current Budokan opened in the Kishine Park, administered by the K. P. G. Board of Education.
<b>Old building</b> 1956	After restoration work, Budokan reopened as the venue for judo, kendo and kyudo.	<b>New building</b> 2020	K. P. G. introduced the naming right for Budokan.
<b>Old building</b> 1977	Budokan was relocated due to the construction of Yokohama Stadium in the park.	<b>New building</b> 2024	After renovation, Budokan reopened and held a celebration.


